ADDENDUM-III

SUB: 'Integrated Collection and Transportation of Municipal Solid Waste and Street Sweeping Waste in Najafgarh Zone'

NIT NO.: F.120/E-in-C/SDMC/2017/13 dated 07.07.2017.

Following are the amendments in the RFP document (Vol.-I) / Project Information Memorandum (PIM) Vol.-II / Draft Concession Agreement (Vol.-III):-

- 1) **Clause 2.10.2 of RFP Document is amended as under:-**
"The Financial Bid should be contained in Part II only. Inclusion of Financial Bid in other part would lead to disqualification of the Proposal."
- 2) **The clause 2.19.2 of RFP document is amended as under:-**
Applicant/Bidders are advised to quote CTC after carefully evaluating scope of project and resources deployment.
- 3) **The clause 2.20.1(c) of RFP document is amended as under:-**
2.20.1
c) The various cost components are assumed as follows:-
 - a. 5% towards CNG Component.
 - b. 15% towards HSD/Fuel Component.
 - c. 35% towards labour Component.
 - d. 25% towards plant and/spares Component.
 - e. 20% towards other Component.
- 4) **The clause 2.25 of RFP document is amended as under:-**
"GST on CTC if applicable shall be reimbursed by SDMC as per actual in addition to agreed CTC."
- 5) **The clauses 3.2.1(i) & (ii) of RFP document is amended as under:-**
3.2.1. **Turnover:-**
 - i) The bidder should have average annual financial turn over of at least Rs. 25 cr. (Rupees Twenty Five Crore) during the immediate last 3 consecutive financial year. The last available 3 consecutive balance sheet duly audited by Chartered Accountant. If any foreign firm is either bidding directly or as a consortium member, then technical and financial qualification document shall be apostile from the respective Embassy/High commission of the respective country.
 - ii) Bidder should not have incurred any loss in more than two years in last five financial years as per the last available balance sheet duly audited by Chartered Accountant.



6) The clause 2.20.3 of RFP document is amended as under:-

Price adjustment for increase or decrease in the cost POL (fuel and lubricants) shall be paid in accordance with the following formula:

$$V_f = 0.85 \times P_f / 100 \times R \times (F_1 - F_0) / F_0$$

V_f = increase or decrease in the cost of work during the month under consideration due to changes in the rates for fuel and lubricants.

F_0 = the official retail price of High Speed Diesel (HSD) at the existing consumer pumps of IOC at Delhi, on the date of submission of Bids.

F_1 = the average of daily official retail price of High Speed Diesel (HSD) at the existing consumer pumps of IOC at Delhi, during the quarter previous to the one under consideration to which a particular interim payment certificate is related.

P_f = Percentage of fuel and lubricants component of the work shall be 10%.

Note: For the application of this clause, the price of High Speed Diesel oil has been chosen to represent Fuel and Lubricants group.

7) The clause 2.1 (l) of PIM document is amended as under:-

In case MTS is not stationed at the designated location at that point of time for any reason, then the 'loaded Auto Tipper' shall go to the next designated location of the 'MTS or FCTS' to unload the waste.

8) The clauses 2.1 Tab e-4 Prohibited activity and action against of PIM is amended as under:-

i) Auto Tipper (AT 1.75) engaged in this service shall not lift waste from Dhalaos, open sites, ground and drains. **AT 1.75** with mechanical "Bin-Lifting" capability / to lift 240 liter bin/120 liter bin (**AT 1.75 with Bin lifting Capability**) shall collect the MSW from street level and from bins of 240 liter / 120 liter capacity.

ii) MTS engaged in this service shall not transport the waste received from any source other than the source specified in the PIM.

9) The clause 2.2 (a) & (g) of PIM is amended as under:-

2.2 Collection and Transportation of MSW from All Markets (Vegetable Market, Fruit Market, Daily Market, Fish Market, Street Vendors etc.), Hotels, Dhabas, Restaurants, Banquet Hall, Institution, **Schools, Colleges**, Farm House & Other Commercial Establishments.

a) Providing "Time-Table" bound primary MSW collection service to all Markets (Vegetable Market, Fruit Market, Daily Market, Fish Market, Street Vendors), Hotels, Dhabas, Restaurants, Banquet Hall, Institution, **Schools, Colleges**, Farm House & Other Commercial Establishments (as directed by SDMC).

g) Concessionaire shall plan to collect waste from Markets, Hotels, Dhabas, Restaurants, Banquet Hall, Farm House, Schools, Colleges & other Commercial Establishments in coinciding with opening time of these establishments.

10) The clause 2.4(i) of PIM is amended as under:-

"Concessionaire shall install the CCTV Cameras at the locations where FCTS to be installed. Concessionaire shall be responsible for recording waste collection
