2.	3 Methodology	Methodology devised for the present study is presented in figure 3.1 Study team will conduct a reconnaissance visit to all the 20 locations along with the representative from the MCD and also collect the necessary secondary data from the concerned officials if available any. Based on the reconnaissance visits, after reconnaissance the study team will finalize about 20 locations wherein 7 days traffic data collection by use of Automated Traffic Count & Classification System. All the hard copy and the above said data as well as soft copy will be submitted to SDMC along with the Final Report. In the subsequent sections the conduct of the various traffic surveys have been discussed briefly. In the present study, it is proposed to carry out following types of traffic surveys in one direction i.e. vehicles entering into Delhi: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All the Commercial vehicles Survey entering into Delhi paying MCD Toll Tax including the MCD Toll Tax concessional pass holding commercial vehicles survey. (Yellow plate Commercial vehicles).</li><li>Traffic Volume count survey at 20 entry point of Delhi by using Automated Traffic Count &amp; Classification System where traffic flow is high.</li></ul> The above surveys are described in detail in the subsequent sections.
