As a proof of the successfully carrying out the eligible work, copy of the work order/contract agreement and work performance certificate, issued by the Engineer/Officer-in-charge (not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent) shall be required to be submitted by the bidder.

Terms and Conditions of NIT

- 1. The time of completion for each work has been mentioned against each. However depending on the requirement of the machinery, the hiring may be curtailed at any time during the execution of the contract based on the actual requirement, without any liability on the part of the SDMC. The engagement/hiring of the vehicle may also be extended for a further period of 90 Days on the awarded rates only.**
- 2. The work shall be started within 3 days of issuance of works orders /or as per the direction of the Engineer-in-Charge, and no extension shall normally be given**
- 3. The agency has to submit the copy of the Registration Certificate (RC) of the vehicle, it intends to deploy while submitting the tender online. Any agency not submitting the copy of the RC shall not be eligible for opening of financial bid.**
- 4. The contractor/bidder has to deposit the requisite tender cost/earnest money in order to qualify for these works.**
- 5. The Special Terms & Conditions for Vehicles Contract annexed herewith shall be binding on the contractor and form part of the NIT/Contract agreement.**
- 6. Special conditions of NGT and EIA Guidelines Manual given below will be applicable strictly.**
7. The contractor shall not store/dump construction material or debris on metallic road.
8. The contractor shall get prior approval from Engineer-in-Charge for the area where the construction material or debris can be stored beyond the metallic road. This area shall not cause any obstruction to the free flow of traffic/inconvenience to the pedestrians. It should be ensured by the contractor that no accidents occur on account of such permissible storage.
9. The contractor shall take appropriate protection measures like raising wind breakers of appropriate height on all sides of the plot/area using CGI sheets or plastic and/or other similar material to ensure that no construction material dust fly outside the plot area.
10. The contractor shall ensure that all the trucks or vehicles of any kind which are used for construction purposes/or are carrying construction material like cement, sand and other allied material are fully covered. The contractor shall take every necessary precautions that the vehicles are properly cleaned and dust free to ensure that enroute their destination, the dust, sand or any other particles are not released in air/contaminate air.
11. The contractor has to first develop 100 mtr. space on both side of intersection in first phase in 60 days for the display and inauguration purpose.
12. The contractor shall provide mask to every worker working on the construction site and involved in loading, unloading and carriage of construction material and construction debris to prevent inhalation of dust particles.
13. The contractor shall provide all medical help, investigation and treatment to the workers involved in the construction of building and carry of construction material and debris relating to dust emission.
14. The contractor shall ensure that C&D waste is transported to the C&D waste site only and due record shall be maintained by the contractor.
15. The contractor shall compulsory use of wet jet in grinding and stone cutting.
16. The contractor shall comply all the preventive and protective environment steps as stated in the MoEF guidelines,2010
17. The contractor shall carry out on-Road-inspection for black smoke generating machinery. The contractor shall use cleaner fuel.
18. The contractor shall ensure that all DG sets comply emissions norms notified by MoEF.

19. The contractor shall use vehicles having pollution under control certificate. The emissions can be reduced by a large extent by reducing the speed of a vehicle to 20kmph. Speed bumps shall be used to ensure speed reduction. In cases where speed reduction cannot effectively reduce fugitive dust, the contractor shall divert traffic to nearby paved areas.
20. The contractor shall ensure that the construction material is covered by tarpaulin. The contractor shall take all other precaution to ensure that no dust particles are permitted to pollute air quality as a result of such storage.
21. The paving of the path for plying of vehicles carrying construction material is more permanent solution to dust control and suitable for longer duration projects. The NIT approving authority shall carryout cost benefit ratio analysis of the same.
22. The contractor shall quote their rate up to two decimals only. In case, the contractor quotes his rate in three or more decimals, such tender will be out rightly rejected.
23. Since, it is an urgent nature of work, the contractor has to work in all the three shifts to adhere to the timeline given above
24. The agency shall indemnify SDMC Staff against all court cases etc for its operations in this contract.

The demand draft will be received for tender cost and earnest money in favour of "Commissioner, South Delhi Municipal Corporation" and As per circular No. D-086/Com/SDMC/2013 dated 18.02.2013 the Demand Draft should have a clear validity of two months at the time of submission. The detail of Tender Cost & Earnest Money deposited vide Demand Drafts must be entered with draft number and name of bank at the time of downloading/purchasing by the contractor.

- (ii) If the rates quoted by the lowest tenderer are found abnormally low the payment to the contractor for the work shall only be made after inspection by the Quality Control Cell at different stages and these findings shall be final and binding on the contractor. All the testing charges from the independent laboratory shall be borne by the contractor. In case, the lowest contractor fails to commence/complete the work within the stipulated period, the contractor shall be liable for disciplinary action as per the provision of the enlistment rule/ instruction issued from time to time.
